Leadership Commitments

Each manager commits, with respect to each employer for which that manager is responsible, to:

- Ensuring that employees are trained on safe work practices and procedures.
- Ensuring that contractors, suppliers, and visitors comply with applicable laws, regulations, and internal health & safety standards.
- Fulfilling all material legal and other requirements, regulations, company standards and procedures
 pertaining to health and safety topics including, but not limited to:, personal protective equipment,
 machine safety, emergency preparedness, incident and accident management, workplace ergonomics,
 safe handling of chemicals, fire protection, confined spaces and electrical safety.
- Receiving and welcoming consultation and participation from workers, and where they exist, worker's representatives at each employer.

Employee Commitments - Shared Safety Practices

- Employees must work safely and promptly report all unsafe conditions or acts to management.
- Employees must share our commitments to Zero In On Safety and our 5 Basic Safety Foundations.
